Full responsibility for an animal should be preceded by a period of learning about the animal and closely supervised direct contact so that the child can become acquainted with both the animal and how it should be handled. "Responsible adult supervisors" should determine that the leadline rider has the ability to safely and cautiously move around the animal before participating in mounted activities and participating in Youth Fair.

"Responsible adult supervisors" are defined as the parent/legal guardian of the child or an adult who has been officially designated by the parent/legal guardian via the **CHAPERONE DESIGNATION/PARENTAL PERMISSION FORM**.
