

2010 State Fair Qualifiers

In the Horse Program, You MUST have Two (2) Qualifiers to be Eligible for the 2010 State Fair Selection.

- A. **Participation in Horse Bowl:** If offered the Horse Bowl Chairperson will set attendance requirements at the first session. **Counts as (1) qualifiers, or determined by attendance.**
- B. **Participation in Hippology.** If offered the Hippology Chairperson will set attendance requirements at the first session. **Counts as (1) qualifier.**
- C. **Participation in Horse Judging Team.** If offered the Horse Judging Team Coach will set attendance requirements. **Counts as (1) qualifier.**
- D. **Public Presentation:** Give a presentation at the County Public Presentation Day Event in February **Counts as (1) qualifier.**
- E. **Attendance at the Onondaga County lecture series** at least three (3) out of the four (4) lectures. **Counts as (1) qualifier.**
- F. **“June” Clinic** (fee involved), if offered. **Counts as (1) qualifier if you stay all day.**
- G. **Active 4-H Horse Program Committee Member.** **Counts as (1) qualifier.**
- H. A **community service project** of 6 hours or more with either a diary, photo presentation, or report submitted to Cooperative Extension by June 15, 2010. **Counts as (1) qualifier.**
- I. **Drill or Parade Team Participant.** **Counts as two (2) qualifiers.** Coach should submit a record of practice or attendance.
- J. Participation in **clinics** offered by other counties, or professionals, pre-approved or documented/ reported, and completed between the last day of Youth Fair and June 15, 2010. **Counts as (1) qualifier.**
- K. **Teen Leadership with an educational presentation/clinic** to another club(s) or event, pre-approved and documented/reported. **Counts as (1) qualifier.**

STATE FAIR SELECTION WILL BE BASED ON THE FOLLOWING:

- **Youth are enrolled 4-H members as of January 1, 2010.**
- Submission of the Horse Certificate, Health Papers, and 4-H Project Record by 4:30 p.m. on Friday, June 15, 2010.
- Demonstrated skill and knowledge attained as evidenced by placement in Youth Fair classes.
- Completion of two (2) qualifiers as outlined on the enclosure.
